

Salvia 'Rubin's Baby'

Rubin's Baby Sage

PERENNIAL SHRUB
1.5 - 2' high, 3' wide, groundcover.
Less woody stems, more compact.
Medium green leaves, oblanceolate.
Lavendar blue flowers, spring-
summer.

Native Habitat: possible *S. munzii*
hybrid, which is from foothills of San
Diego to northern Baja California -
500' - 3000'.

Full sun to partial shade.
Best in well-drained soil, but clay-
tolerant.
Water 1-2x/month in summer; more
water tolerant than other sages.

Can be used near traditionally
watered garden.
Tolerates more shade than most
sages.
