## Salvia mellifera 'Terra Seca' Terra Seca Sage, Prostrate Black Sage

SUBSHRUB - evergreen/drought deciduous.

1 - 2' high, 6'+ wide. Spreading.
Sticky, aromatic, linear leaves.
White flowers in pagoda-like clusters at ends of stems - spring to summer.

Horticultural selection from the Channel Islands.

Full sun to part shade.

Sensitive to prolonged or extreme cold.

Best with good drainage.

Best with some summer water - 1 - 2 x / month once established, but will die if overwatered.

Groundcover, slope stabilizer.

Grows fast.

Can get gangly in garden, so tip-prune continually.

Semi-dormant by end of summer.

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
