

Salvia 'Vicky Romo'

Vicky Romo Sage

SUBSHRUB - evergreen.

5' high, 5' spread. Can be trimmed and kept to 3' by 3.'

Frosted gray-green leaves. Delicate, fragrant.

Pink flowers on long spikes - April to July.

Hybrid, most likely between *S. clevelandii* and *S. apiana*.

Full sun to part shade.

Tolerates sandy soil.

Frost resistant.

Drought tolerant but can use some summer water (1 x /month).

Slopes, mixed plantings.

Attracts bees, butterflies, hummingbirds.

Can be used in cooking.

Pruning following bloom will improve appearance and increase bloom the next year.
