

Salvia mellifera var. *repens*
Creeping Black Sage

WOODY SUBSHRUB

1-2' high, 3-6' spread.

Leaves dark green, wrinkled, aromatic.

Flowers light blue — April to July.

Horticultural selection.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub.

Full sun to part shade.

Not very frost tolerant.

Prefers well draining soil.

Can grow in sand or gravel, but not well.

Needs no water, but better with 1 x / month.

Good as ground cover.

Best on coastal bluffs.

Attracts butterflies, hummingbirds.

Best with some pruning.
