HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL - evergreen  
<1' high, 3'wide. Slender, trailing stems. Mat-forming.  
Bright green rounded leaves with minty fragrance.  
Flowers white to lavender - April to September.

Native habitat: chaparral, woodland - shaded woods below  
3000' - Santa Monica Mountains north to British Columbia.

Sun to full shade.

Water 2 - 4 x /month. Needs moisture through first summer.

Groundcover for coastal shade garden. Dried leaves good for tea.
