Stachys ajugoides Hedge Nettle

PERENNIAL, from rhizome, semi-deciduous.
1-2' high, spreading.
Leaves have long, silky hairs.
Flowers pink, in clusters along stem — June to October.

Native habitat: moist open areas, below 3000' — freshwater marsh, riparian, coastal sage scrub, some forests western California to British Columbia.

Part shade. Tolerates clay. Moderate amount of water, depending on location.

Good in perennial flower border. Can form groundcover.
