

Adenostoma sparsifolium
Redshanks

TREE-LIKE SHRUB - evergreen.

10 to 20' high, equal spread. Can be puffy shrub or pruned to tree shape.

Bright green leaves are about 1/2" long and in pairs.

Clusters of tiny white flowers are fragrant - summer.

Red-brown trunk bark forms ribbons.

Native habitat: dry slopes, flats, chaparral below 6000' - peninsular, central coastal and transverse ranges to Baja California.

Full sun. Frost resistant.

Water 1/x /month when established.
