Amorpha fruticosa False Indigo, Desert Indigobush

LARGE SHRUB - summer deciduous.3 - 8' (to 12') high, equal spread.Dense, shrubby.Flowers an intense purple - early spring. Aromatic.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, chaparral; stream banks, canyons below 5000': throughout southern California but also to Manitoba and north Mexico.

Full sun-part shade. Frost resistant.Well drained soil. No summer water needed, but likes moist soil.Pruning improves the shape.

Good for erosion control, windbreaks, conservation plantings, wildlife habitat.
