GROUNDCOVER - evergreen

1 - 2' high, 6' spread. Mounding, spreading, branching habit. Leaves gray green with reddish edge. New growth bronze. Light pink flowers; sparse: winter to early spring.

Horticultural selection from central coast, Monterey county.

Full sun to part shade.

Garden tolerant.

Water 2x/month, once established

Growth moderate to rapid - one of the fastest growing varieties.

Good for small gardens. Prefers coastal conditions, but does nicely in protected inland locations.
