SHRUB, WOODY PERENNIALTo 3 - 4' high, spreadingLeaves smooth above, slightly woolly beneath.Flowers pinky white, berries red turning brown.

Native habitat: Chaparral, coast of San Digo County. Not a "garden species" but probably suitable for planting in chaparral landscapes.

Full sun to part shade. Does well in rocky areas.

Large basal burl.
