Baccharis emoryi Emory's Baccharis

SHRUB - evergreen.

3 - 10' high, 4 - 6' spread.

Woody, upright growth - sticky.

Dioecious.

Lower leaves toothed.

Flowers in clusters, creamy, often sticky - fall.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, riparian - sandy edges of rivers, washes, salt marsh below 2000' - central and southern California to Texas.

Full sun to full shade.

Frost resistant.

Tolerates sandy soils.

Water 2 x /month once established.

Grows quickly.

Good for hot desert areas.
