PERENNIAL VINE - deciduous
Stems to 12' long.
Leaves triangular.
Elevers white with pipk purple areas

Flowers white with pink-purple areas - March to August.

Native habitat: Grows from coast to mountans below 3000' - from central Californian coast to Baja California.

Full sun or part shade.

Tolerates poor soil and will grow in rocky areas. Drought tolerant.

Great for restoration or on slopes.
