LOW SHRUB - evergreen.

2 - 3' high, 6'+ spread.

Prostrate with stiff angular branches.

Large shiny leaves. Dark green above, lighter beneath.

Dark blue flowers fading lighter - spring.

Horticultural selection from Yankee Point, Monterey County.

Full sun best at the coast, part shade inland.

Not frost resistant.

Well-drained soil, not clay.

Adaptable to watering but overwatering can shorten life.

Growth rapid (4 - 6' in a year).

Dependable and clean.

The most widely used California native groundcover.

Expect to replace every 5 to 10 years.
