SHRUB - evergreen.6 - 15' high, 10'+ spread.Dense foliage of tiny, glossy, dark green leaves.Clusters of creamy blossoms - March to May.Unusual seed plume - showy, fluffy white streamers.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, chaparral - hills, valleys, foothills below 3000' - southern Peninsular Range in San Diego County to northern Baja California.

Full sun to part shade. Frost resistant.Tolerates adobe soil.Drought tolerant, once established, but can take some summer water (2 x /month).

Good screen. Easily maintained at chosen height.
