ANNUAL

3' high, 2' spread.

Leaves narrow.

Flowers vary in color from lavender or pale pink to dark wine-red
- April to July.

Native habitat: open, grassy or shrubby places below 5000' -
from Washington state to Baja California.

Full sun.

Will tolerate poor soil.

Drought resistant but better with some water.

Good contrast color in a border.
