ANNUAL

Up to 3' high, to 3' wide. Plants are branched.

Flowers spread out along the stem and bloom over a long period of time. Usually dark pink, but can be more orange - late spring to summer.

Native habitat: grassland, woodland and chaparral below 5000' - coast range from Mendocino County to San Diego County and Sierra Nevada foothills.

Full sun to part shade.

Drought tolerant but better with some water.

Good at the back of a border or just by itself for wonderful color. Self-seeds.
