HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL - deciduous.

2' high, 3' spread.

Narrow-lobed leaves.

Yellow daisy flowers in spring.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, strands and bluffs, below 200'
- San Diego County to Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.

Salt spray tolerant. Can take heavy soil.

Water 1x /month once established. Can Naturalize.

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California, but more common elsewhere. Fairly endangered in California)
