PERENNIAL SUCCULENT - evergreen.
6 - 10" spread.
20 - 45 succulent leaves in single basal rosette.
Flowers pale yellow, in clusters - spring.

Native habitat: rocky places, north facing slopes below 1200'
- Santa Cruz and Santa Rosa Islands where it is endemic.

Sun to partial shade. Frost tolerant.
Do not water in summer unless in sandy soil or in a container.

Use in rock gardens or containers. Good as long-lived specimen plant.

RARE — CNPS List: 1B.2

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere. Fairly endangered in California).
