SUCCULENT - evergreen

6 to 10" high, 6 to 10" spread.

Round elongated leaves, with gray-green appearance and sometimes a red tip.

Flowers creamy white on stems to 2' long - May to June.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, chaparral - rocky hillsides below 3500'; southern coast of California to Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.

Drought tolerant. Water sparingly.

Good for rock gardens and containers.

Flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies.
