SUCCULENT - evergreen rosette.
Leaves green, covered with a slight whitish film.
Flowers pink, sometimes yellowish - April to June.

Native habitat: rolling hills and mesas, lower and upper Sonoran zones - San Vicente to San Fernando, Northern Baja California.

Full sun.
Water sparingly.

Collected in central coastal Baja California. Unusual.
Good for rock gardens, container gardening.
Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.
