

Epilobium canum (*Zauchneria californica*)

California Fuchsia

HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL

1 - 2' high, 4' spread.

Erect or spreading.

Leaves gray to green.

Bright red-orange flowers - summer to fall.

Native habitat: dry, mostly stony or gravelly places below 3500' - Baja California to northern California.

Full sun to part shade.

Frost resistant.

Well-drained soil.

Drought tolerant, but best with some summer water (1 x /month).

Perennial borders, dry banks.

Good cut flowers.

Attracts hummingbirds.

Can/should be pruned back after bloom.
