## California Fuchsia Route 66

PERENNIAL SUBSHRUB

2' high, 4' spread.

Upright but compact with bright green narrow leaves.

Flowers red to orange-red, tubular - summer to early fall.

Horticultural selection.

Full sun to part shade.

Drought tolerant - water 1 x /month once established.

Excellent as a border plant for color. Good for cut flowers.

Attracts Hummingbirds and butterflies.
