HERBACEOUS SUBSHRUB

1 - 2' high, 2 - 3' spread. Erect wooly stems from woody base. Gray-green leaves.

Small bright yellow daisies in dense heads - April to August.

Native habitat: brushy slopes in many plant communities, below 8000' - throughout California.

Full sun to part shade. Frost resistant.

Well-drained soil.

Drought tolerant, but looks better and blooms longer with summer water.

Good in mixed borders, rock gardens. Good cut flowers. Cut back after blooming.
