Eschscholzia californica (& Hybrids) California Poppy (Hybrids)

ANNUAL

Variable height to a foot or more. Slender stems. Leaves mostly basal.

Flowers yellows to red-orange - spring to summer.

Native habitat: grassy, open areas below 7000' - throughout California, to south Washington state, New Mexico and northwestern Baja California.

Full sun.

Water during active growth.

Summer water extends bloom.

Plants may reseed after blooming, and may resprout a second year.
Bright spot in border or mixed bed. Especially nice with blue flowers.
