CACTUS

1' high, 1' across.

Barrel form. Ribs prominent.

Spines heavy and curved.

Yellow-green flowers - May to June. Greenish red fruit.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, grassland - dry hills up to 2500' - San Diego County to northwest Baja California. Full sun to part shade. Frost resistant. No water.

Good as specimen in the garden or in a pot.
