

# *Galvezia speciosa* & Horticultural selections Island Bush Snapdragon

HERBACEOUS SUBSHRUB -  
evergreen.

2 - 3' high, 3' spread.

'Firecracker' is a compact form.

Leaves tomentose.

Bright red flowers - spring to  
summer.

Native habitat: Rocky cliffs and  
canyons below 3000' -  
Channel Islands, Guadalupe  
Island.

*Galvesia speciosa* 'Firecracker' is a  
horticultural selection from *G.*  
*speciosa*.

Full sun near the coast, part shade  
inland.

Drought tolerant.

Water 1 - 2 x /month.

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
