

Gutierrezia californica
California Matchweed

SUBSHRUB

2' high, erect or rambling. Stems can be reddish.

Leaves dark gray-green.

Flower heads have 8 to 20 yellow blooms.

Native habitat: grasslands, slopes, outcrops, sand dunes below 1000' - central western California to northwest Baja California.

Full sun.

Needs good drainage.

Intolerant of frequent summer water.

Good on slopes.

Toxic to livestock fresh or dry.
