PERENNIAL WITH UNDERGROUND STEMS

6" high, spreads to several feet.

- Leaves are fleshy, narrow, blade-like and bright green with slight whitish coating.
- Flower heads are yellow with slight purple areas May to October.

Native habitat: Coastal salt marshes and bases of sea cliffs - coast from British Columbia to northern Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.

Best in alkaline, wet soil conditions but can be drought tolerant when established. Keep moist to retain fleshy green leaves.

Good habitat plant.
