ANNUAL

6 - 12" high.

Dark colored stems. Narrow leaves are hairy.

Flowers yellow with white tips appearing as a white border.

Native habitat: grassland and open areas below 7000' - Mendocino County south to northwestern Baja California.

Full sun.

Watering will increase flowering period.

Best when many plants together. Excellent planted with globe gilia or blue-flowering lupines.
