

Leymus condensatus Giant Wild Rye

PERENNIAL RYE GRASS -
evergreen.

To 9' high when in bloom.

Spreads slowly by underground
runners to form a mound
about 6' wide.

Leaves are medium green, broad.
Large, very striking flower/seed
heads - summer.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub,
chaparral, woodland below
5000' in western central and
southern California and Baja
California.

Full sun to part shade.

Frost resistant.

Grows in most soils as long as
they are not too wet or too
dry.

Water sparingly (1 - 2 x/month).

Can be used as an accent piece.

Use to stabilize slopes.

Can be contained using a root barrier.
