

Leymus condensatus 'Canyon Prince' Canyon Prince Giant Wild Rye

PERENNIAL RYE GRASS - evergreen.

To 5' high.

Spreads slowly by underground runners to form a mound.

Foliage is a striking pale blue green color.

Flower stalks powdery blue, on younger plants - summer.

Cultivar from *Leymus condensatus* which grows below 5000' in western central and southern California and Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.

Grows in most soils as long as they are not too wet or too dry.

Water sparingly (1 - 2 x/month).

Can be used as an accent piece.

Use to stabilize slopes.

Can be contained using a root barrier.
