

Lillium pardinalum

Leopard Lily, Panther Lily

PERENNIAL, from a bulb
6 - 8' high.

Leaves often in whorls.

Flowers bell-shaped, pale orange to red with maroon spots, to 3"
wide - May to July.

Native habitat: moist places, streambanks, California floristic
province to southern Oregon - below 6500'.

Full sun to shade.

Frost tolerant.

Needs consistently damp soil.

Similar to *Lilium humboldtii*.

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
