Chaparral Honeysuckle

VINING SHRUB - evergreen, but may be semi-deciduous.
4'+ high, 3 - 5'+ spread, climbing or trailing.
Creamy white, fragrant flowers in early summer, followed by orange to red berries, depending on subspecies.

Native habitat: chaparral - dry slopes below 6000' - High Sierra Nevada, central western California to southwestern California.

Full sun to part shade. Moderately frost resistant.
Can tolerate heavy soil.
Drought resistant but can use water 1 x /month.

Good for growing over banks. Good under oak trees.
Rapid grower.
