WOODY SUBSHRUB

To 5' high, 3' spread.

Sticky leaves.

Blooms profusely in spring; light bloom again in the fall.

Flower color varies from orange to red.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, chaparral

- hills, foothills, canyons up to 5000' in central and southern California.

Full sun (on coast) to part shade (inland or coast).

Needs well-drained soil.

Water while growing and blooming. No water when dormant.

Good for dry border or foundation planting.
