HERBACEOUS usually perennial
1' (from 1" to 4') high, 2' spread.

Underground rootstock.

Erect or decumbent.

Golden yellow flowers often dotted with red — April to June.

Native habitat: wet places throughout California below 10,000'.

Full sun–light shade.

Likes moist soil.

Best in or around a pond or in a mixed border with plenty of water.

Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.
