## ANNUAL.

Size varies, but usually 4 - 6 " high, spreading to 12" - cultivars tend to be bigger.

Leaves and stems are hairy.

Flowers are a beautiful blue with a white center - the blue color can vary - spring to early summer.

Native habitat: meadows, fields, grasslands, canyons below 6500' - throughout California to Oregon and Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.

Will flower until it gets hot. Water will encourage growth and flowering.

Can use in container. Great at the front of a border.
