## Nolina parryi ssp. wolfii Wolf's Beargrass

TREE-LIKE SUBSHRUB - evergreen. 8 to 15' high, 8+' spread.

Yucca-like plant with one or sev-

eral stems above ground. Rosette of 40 to 200 generally olive-green leaves.

Large heads of creamy flowers - spring, summer after plant is around 35 years old.

Native habitat: dry slopes, ridges 3000' to 6000' - mainly Kern plateau, Santa Rosa, San Jacinto, Kingston, Little San Bernardino mountains.

Full sun to part shade. Frost resistant.

Well-drained soil.

Water 1 x /month.

Wonderful accent plant for large, longterm landscapes. Goes well with cacti, yucca, jojoba.
