HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL

2' high, 2' spread. Many-stemmed; upright or spreading. Narrow, pointed leaves.

Bi-colored tubular flowers: intense rose violet, lilac to blue - blooms spring to late summer. Colors can vary.

Horticultural selection introduced by Las Pilitas Native Plant Nursery. Suitable for chaparral, oak woodland, coastal sage scrub or yellow pine woodland.

Disease resistant.

Full sun–part. Frost and heat tolerant.

Well-drained, rocky soil best.

Little to moderate summer water, but blooms longer (into October) with more.

Good for borders in front of large shrubs. Can be cut back after blooming. Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.
