## Pinus jeffreyi Jeffrey Pine

CONIFER - evergreen.

60 - 180' high.

Symmetrical crown, often pendulous branches.

Bark reddish-brown in irregular scaly plates. Deep furrows emit vanilla-like scent when warm.

Grayish blue-green needles in bundls of three, 5 - 10" long. Cones 5 - 10" long, not prickly.

Native habitat: dry slopes, upper mixed-conifer, red-fir forests, elsewhere on serpentine, mostly 5,000 - 9,000 - northern Baja California to southern Oregon.

Hybridizes with *Pinus coulteri* and *Pinus ponderosa*. One of the best bonsai trees.
