## Platanus racemosa California Sycamore

TREE - deciduous.
40'+ high, 30' spread.
Often multi-trunked. Majestic.
Mottled, peeling white bark.
Very large palmate leaves turn dusty brown in autumn.
Seed balls hang in long clusters from branches.

Native habitat: along streambeds and water courses below 6500' - Baja California to central California.

Full sun. Frost resistant. Heat and wind tolerant. Needs deep water, moist soil.

## For large gardens.

Grows rapidly under good conditions. Nesting habitat for many birds including Nuttall's Woodpecker, Bullock Oriole.

Important for Western Tiger Swallowtail Butterflies.
