## Rosa californica California Wild Rose

SHRUB - semi-deciduous.

3 - 6' high, 5' spread. Mounding. Prickly.

Fresh green leaves.

Fragrant pink flowers - profuse throughout summer.

Red rose hips - summer through fall.

Native habitat: fairly moist places, near streams, etc. below 6000'

- Baja California to Oregon.

Full sun to shade. Frost resistant.

Adaptable to different soils.

Needs some summer water - 2 - 4 x/month, once established.

Great in wildlife gardens - forms thickets as well as having fruit for birds. Effective barrier plant alone or with other plants such as coffeeberry,

pink-flowering currant.

Good on gentle slopes for erosion control (with irrigation).
