

Salvia clevelandii 'Pozo Blue'

SUBSHRUB—evergreen

3' high.

Leaves gray-green leaves. Delicate, fragrant.

Lavender to violet-blue flowers on long spikes— May to August.

Hybrid (introduction from Las Pilitas) -

Salvia clevelandii x *S. leucophylla*.

Full sun—part shade. Frost resistant.

Tolerates sandy and clay soils.

Little or no supplemental water, once established.

Slopes, mixed plantings. Attracts bees and hummingbirds. Good substitute for *S. officinalis* in cooking. Pruning following bloom will improve appearance and increase bloom the following year.
