

*Symphoricarpos albus* (*Symphoricarpos rivularis*)  
Snowberry

SHRUB - deciduous

To 6' high. Stiff branches spreading out. Spreads by rhizome.  
Flowers in pink clusters - spring.  
Striking white fruit in fall to winter.

Native habitat: shady woods, north slopes, streambanks below  
4000' - from southwestern California to Alaska.

Part shade to full shade. Frost resistant.

Drought tolerant when established, but can be watered 1 - 2 /  
month.

Excellent for use under oak trees.

Berries valuable source of food for some birds.

Berries may be toxic for humans.
