

Vitis californica 'Roger's Red' Roger's Red Grape

VINE—deciduous.
Stems 3 to 20' long. Strong climber.
Leaves spectacular red color in fall.
Flowers—May to June. Dark, blue-black berries.

Horticultural variety.

Sun to part shade.
Moist soil. Drought tolerant when established.

Edible berries attract birds.
Does well under trees such as oaks.
Although deciduous, red leaves remain through fall, so only a short time without leaves.
