PERENNIAL SHRUB

2'-3' high, 4'-6' wide, mounding.

Many branched green stems, trailing to ascending. Woody with age. Leaves narrow, green, evergreen.

Plant dioecious, male flowers white, female creamy; abundant in fall.

Native Habitat: this is a hybrid cultivar: Parents occupy chaparral, sage scrub and desert areas, under 4500'.

Full sun Most soils, not standing water. Water 1 - 2x/month, if needed.

Less water promotes denser growth. Good on slopes, or as border. Prune in winter if needed.
