Ceanothus 'Joyce Coulter' Joyce Coulter Ceanothus

LOW SHRUB - evergreen. 3 - 5' high, 10 - 12' spread.

Mounding, spreading.

Bright green, linear leaves.

Rich blue flowers in long clusters give spectacular bloom over long season - April to May.

Hybrid, random: *C. thrysiflorus* x *C. papilosus roweanus*. Full sun.

Well-drained soil best, but can tolerate heavy soil.

Water 1 - 2 / x month once established.

Good background, slopes and banks - not near lawns.

Tolerates garden conditions, both coastal and inland if protected from extreme heat.
