

Coreopsis gigantea Giant Coreopsis, Giant Sea Dahlia

HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL -
drought deciduous.

3 - 4' high, 2' spread.

Stout fleshy trunk.

Ferny foliage emerges after
rains.

Clusters of yellow daisies,
3" in diameter - spring.

Native habitat: coastal sage
scrub; strands, bluffs up
to 150' - south central
coast (Santa Barbara area),
Channel Islands.

Full sun to part shade.

Not frost tolerant.

Tolerates heavy soils, but better
in well-drained areas.

Does not tolerate summer
irrigation (will rot).

Naturalizes.

Grows rapidly.
