PERENNIAL succulent One or more rosettes, 4-6" tall, 4-12" wide. Basal leaves fleshy, gray-green, evergreen. Flowers on 2"-12" tall cyme, red, orange, yellow, green, or brown depending on variety or subspecies. Spring to summer blooms.

Native Habitat: Rocky outcrops, slopes from California Transverse ranges north to Oregon. Elevation sea level to 11000'.

Partial shade to full sun. Fast drainage. Cold tolerant to -10F. Drought tolerance: very low water, no summer water.

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
