PERENNIAL HERB 1'-3' high stems, spreads via rhizomes Erect, green, round stems. Inconspicuous basal leaves. Flowers on spike at tip of stem. appear

Flowers on spike at tip of stem, appear creamy - spring, summer.



Native Habitat: wetlands, vernal pools, fresh to brackish water, < 7000' - western North America to South America

Full sun Requires saturated, slow-draining soil. Can dry out at end of season.

Use in bioswales or edge of ponds. May spread in wet areas.
