PERENNIAL HERB 1-2' high, 1' wide, spreading. Gray green, linear leaves on erect stems. Flowers bright, red-orange, trumpet-shaped. - late summer and fall.

Native Habitat: dry slopes throughout most of California and NW Mexico under 6500'

Full sun to partial shade

Tolerant of variety of soils and drainage. Should not be constantly wet. Low to very low water; 1x/month in summer encourages flowering.

Good ground cover.

Naturalizes readily and may spread via underground shoots. Cut back in winter.
